### The Key for the Believer is TRUE Truth.

- 1) **God** created. He was before creation. He is "other".  
(Gen. 1:1, John 1:1-10, Psalm 90:2, Ex. 15:11)
- 2) God created *ex nihilo* – all things from **nothing**.  
(Gen. 1 - "God said"; Rom. 4:17, Heb. 11:3)
- 3) God created by His **word**. He spoke and executed His will.  
(Psalm 33:6-9, Heb. 11:3, II Peter 3:5)
- 4) God created **man** different and separate from the rest of creation. (Gen. 1:26; Psalm 8:4-6)
- 5) By the way he was created and by his relationship to the creator, man is **responsible** to the creator. (Gen. 1: 26, 28)

**26 Q Wherein did Christ's humiliation consist?**

A Christ's humiliation consisted in his being born, and that in a low condition (Lu 2:7) made under the law (Ga 4:4), undergoing the miseries of this life (Isa 53:3), the wrath of God (Mt 27:46), and the cursed death of the cross (Php 2:8); in being buried, and continuing under the power of death for a time (Mt 12:40).
